



2022 Pawrade of Dog Homes at the Bark City Festival

Design/Build Competition Guidelines & Application

We encourage teams to create original, fun, interesting and one-of-a-kind designs that will be enjoyed by dogs and people alike! Below are the minimum and basic guidelines that must be met by all competition entries. Any dog homes that do not meeting the below criteria, teams will be asked to re-design, re-build their home or the home may be removed from the competition and/or display at the Bark City Festival.

- All pet homes must provide a safe and comfortable shelter for animals.
- All homes must be designed to accommodate removable bedding.
- All homes designed for outdoor use must be built with exterior-grade materials and provide a sheltered entry and means to keep floor of home dry from natural elements, such as floor being raised slightly off of the ground.
- All doors and/or operable openings must be fixed in the open or closed position with mechanical fasteners.
- All openings 4" or larger must be covered by a minimum of ¼" thick plexiglass and securely attached with mechanical fasteners. Any homes delivered to Mountain Life Church for display without plexiglass installed at the time of arrival, will not be allowed to be set on the Mountain Life Church property.
 - Teams should incorporate the plexiglass into the overall design and avoid creating an enclosure around the home if at all possible.

COMPETITION CATEGORIES

At the time of registration, each team will select their preferred design category. Entries are first-come, first-serve and the category will be closed once the maximum number of entries has been received. Please have a backup design category selected before submitting your team registration.

Bark City Dog (Large) - Six (6) Entries Available

Designs should feature king-sized concepts with large dogs in mind.

Size: 5' wide x 5' high x 5' long (max)

Weight: 500lb (max)

Lap Dog Lounge (Medium) - Six (6) Entries Available

Designs should feature concepts of a medium sized dog who love showing their love for you by sitting on your lap, so show your love back and build them their own space to love.

Size: 3' wide x 4' high x 4' long (max)

Weight: 350lb (max)

Pint Sized Pooch (Small) - Six (6) Entries Available

Designs should feature big-dog creativity in a pint-sized package.

Size: 3' wide x 3' high x 4' long (max)

Weight: 250lb (max)

Size:

Homes will be limited to the maximum size indicated in your design/build category. Any size within the max size range will be deemed acceptable, pending design review approval. Please note that all entries except Bark City Dog should be designed to fit through a standard 3'0" door, however if the Bark City Dog design is intended to be only indoor it should fit through the standard 3'0" door. This helps make sure the winner of the home can install it with ease.

Weight:

Homes cannot exceed the maximum weight limit indicated in your design/build category. Please take into consideration that your team is responsible for transportation and placing of your home. Please also consider the feasibility of transportation and relocation by the eventual owner as well.

Cost:

To ensure fair and equal competition, home material costs should not exceed \$2,500. The cost limit is set in order to reduce significant cost gaps, establish fair and equal pricing for public silent auction bidding and help ensure an equal playing field for all Pawrade of Dog Home competitors.

CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

All homes shall be functional and durable for indoor or outdoor use, using materials to withstand the elements, transportation and reasonable wear and tear. All structures must be complete without exposed nails or other materials that may be harmful to animals.

These structures will be on public display at Mountain Life Church. As such, the homes are likely to be touched by thousands of visitors. Please make sure all design elements are firmly attached, avoid sharp edges or corners and use of unfinished materials.

All openings 4" or larger must be covered with mechanically fastened 1/4" (or thicker) plexiglass to prevent access by patrons while on display at Mountain Life Church. No teams may attach plexiglass

to homes on the Mountain Life Church property. Homes must arrive to Mountain Life Church with plexiglass intact, prior to admittance to Mountain Life Church for display.

If construction requirements are not met at time of delivery, the homes will not be accepted for display and could result in elimination from the design/build competition.

MONEY SHOT SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

DEADLINE: All teams must submit a Money Shot no later than May 9th at 5pm. The Money Shot **MUST** include:

- **Photos of Built Design**
 - One, signature photo that best shows the design and construction detailing of your completed home. This photo will be displayed as THE official photo for your design on the PCAHBA / Bark City Festival website, all social media posts and marketing promotional posts in perpetuity. No late photos will be accepted.
 - No rendered images of homes will be accepted in lieu of actual, completed home photo.
 - All photos must be 1500 pixels by 2100 pixels at 300dpi.

DELIVERY

Teams will deliver and install on Friday, May 13th at Mountain Life Church property located at 7375 Silver Creek Road, Park City UT between 1:00 - 2:00 pm.

DEADLINE AND DELIVERY PENALTIES

Teams that do not meet the required deadlines set forth in the competition guidelines or fail to deliver a completed home on the date of delivery, shall incur the following penalties.

- **Late or Incomplete Dog Home Delivery to Mountain Life Church:** May 13th | 1 - 2 pm
 - \$250 Penalty
- **Withdrawal from Competition after Schematic Design Deadline:**
 - \$500 Penalty
Penalty provides for missed fundraising revenue for PCAHBA due to home/team withdrawal.

HOME SIGNAGE

All homes shall be free of all company logos and/or signage except in designated 8.5 x 11 area on preliminary design submission. Teams may not add any logos for contributing partners nor any products inside the homes that display company names or logos.

Homes that do not meet these requirements will not be allowed for display at Mountain Life Church for the Bark City Festival and may be removed from eligibility for Design/Build awards.

BARK CITY FESTIVAL - PAWRADE OF DOG HOMES AWARDS

All awards will be presented by PCAHBA at the Bark City Festival's Pawrade of Dog Homes Award Ceremony (TBD).

PEOPLE'S PUP HOUSE AWARD

This is the 'People's Choice' award. The built entry that receives the highest bid thus will be deemed as the "People's Pup".

DAPPER DOG AWARD

The "Dapper Dog" award will be presented as the best architectural winner of the Pawrade of Dog Homes design/build competition and overall juror's favorite. This entry will epitomize the best overall design and construction detailing in the pack.

DOG GONE WILD AWARD

The "Dog Gone Wild" award will be presented as the most artistic winner of the Showcase of Dog Homes design/build competition.

DESIGN/BUILD CATEGORY AWARDS (3 TOTAL)

Design/Build awards will be presented to the team that best embraces the spirit of their respective category:

- Bark City Dog - Best Big Dog House Design/Build
- Lap Dog Lounge - Best Medium Sized Dog House Design/Build
- Pint Sized Pooch - Best Small Sized Dog House Design/Build
